Deep garnet-purple colored, the 2018 de la Huste gives up earthy scents of tilled soil, fungi and mossy bark over a core of warm red and black plums and blackberry compote. Full and softly textured with mouth-coating blackberry preserves , it gives a fragrant earth-laced finish.

This Saillans property of 16-hectares has been owned by the same family since 1850. It overlooks the river Isle, which helps to moderate the climate. There are lively red fruits on the nose, which has a fragrant herbal character.

This is highly perfumed, the autumnal fruits clearly well ripened and given room to move even though the tannins are full. It's tight right now, but this is promising and has the structure to age well.

## **VINOUS/ Antonio Galloni**

Score : **87-89**

The 2018 de la Huste is a pretty, understated Fronsac. Sweet floral and spiced overtones add lift to a core of blue/purplish berry fruit. The 2018 is medium in body and restrained in style, especially within the context of the appellation and vintage.

## **JEB DUNNUCK**

Score : **90-92**

The deeply colored 2018 Château De La Huste is another sexy yet pure and precise 2018. Ripe red and black berry fruits, spice, and incense notes all emerge from this medium to full-bodied barrel sample that shows the richness of the vintage yet the freshness and focus as well. It's a beautiful, elegant wine.

## **La Revue du Vin de France**

Score : **14-14,5/20**

Cette belle propriété de Saillans a produit un 2018 bien typé. Le nez est frais, nerveux. La bouche est réservée, un peu ferme. Ce vin aura besoin de temps en cave pour s'épanouir pleinement.

## **VertdeVin**

Score : **89-90/100**

The nose is fruity and offers a small concentration as well as a certain freshness. It reveals notes of ripe cassis, blackberry, small notes of violet associated with touches of small juicy black berries as well as fine hints of spices, a discreet toasted hint, coffee/grilled and vanilla. The palate is fruity, well-balanced and offers an acidulous frame, a good definition, juiciness as well as a racy minerality and a certain tension. On the palate this wine expresses notes of juicy/acidulous cassis, juicy/acidulous blackberry, small notes of violet associated with small touches of small crunchy/juicy red berries, small blue fruits as well as very fine hints of lilac, lily, tonka bean and toasted. Good length. Tannins are finely chewy. A fine chew and a very discreet hint or caramelization on the finish.
