JANCIS ROBINSON

Score : **16+**

Cask sample. Floral and attractive with dark cassis and forest floor, subtle five-spice notes. The palate is medium weight with linear structure, fine tannins and moderate acidity. Should provide good early drinking. (AC)

JAMES SUCKLING

Score : **90 - 91**

A juicy, medium-bodied red with raspberry, rose-petal and hazelnut notes. Lemon zest, too. Soft tannins and a soft, chocolatey finish.

VINOUS – ANTONIO GALLONI

Score : **87 - 89**

The 2021 Château de la Huste is a straightforward, easygoing wine to drink in its youth, while the flavors remain bright. Sweet red cherry, spice and lavender are nicely pushed forward, but the 2021 is a bit lacking in depth.

MARKUS DEL MONEGO

Score : **90**

Deep purple colour with violet hue. Elegant nose with refined fruit, blackcurrants, raspberries, cherries and hints of blueberries. Discreet spiciness in the background. On the palate elegant, rather medium bodied yet with good length, juicy fruit and discreet spiciness.

B MY BORDEAUX – CHRISTER BYCKLUM

Score : **89 - 91**

Ruby. Blackberries, anise, spices, liquorice nose, dark fruits. Fresh acidity, ripe tannins, blackberries, anise, spices, juicy, lovely balance, long finish. Probably the most precise La Huste to date.

ADRIEN VAN VELSEN

Score : **87 - 89**

Rubis moyen. Nez fin, pas trop intense, petits fruits rouges et noirs. Bouche élancée, avec une structure acidulée vive, des tanins modérément prononcés et une finale de longueur moyenne sur les fruits rouges, se terminant par des griottes. Sera amusant tôt. 2023-2032.

FALSTAFF – PETER MOSER

Score : **89**

Strong ruby core, purple reflections, bright, broad rim. Integrated aromas of red cherries, hints of redcurrants with delicate notes of herbs and nougat. Medium body, sweet cherries, ripe tannins, mineral with chocolate touches on the finish.

JEAN-MARC QUARIN

Score : **88**

Belle couleur vive et soutenue. Nez moyennement aromatique, au fruité mûr. Jolie bouche bien construite et savoureuse. Le vin glisse sur le palais, plus minutieux que jamais. Finale agréable, de longueur normale. Degré d'alcool : 13°5 – pH : 3,68. IPT : 73

Score : **87 - 88**

This has plenty of limestone character, clear salinity, grazing full ripeness, and it needs further smoothing over ageing. Redcurrant and blueberry, lemongrass and slate. Austere right now. Brigitte Rullier-Loussert, 34hl/h yield, 15h estate, Eric Boissenot consultant. Harvest September 23 to October 12. One third new oak.

IZAK LITWAR – GREATBORDEAUXWINES

Score : **91 - 92**

Similar to its sister property, Dalem. Spicier fruit and slightly longer finish.
